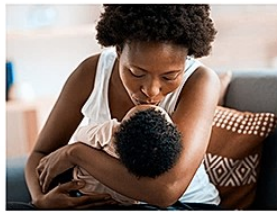
Our sausage sizzle back in September was a great success and we made a profit of **\$630.33**

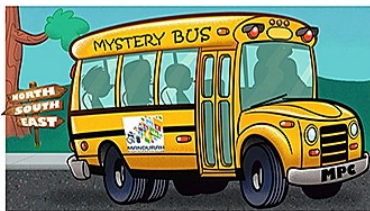
